All programs are licensed by The Department of Education and Early Childhood Development and are eligible for provincial subsidy.

Based on the YMCA Playing to Learn emergent curriculum our all day child care program is licensed by the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador. Parents can drop their children off any time after 7:30 am and pick up any time. The program includes morning, afternoon and evening snacks, and a hot lunch.

Children start the program at the end of their school day and parents can pick children up any time before 6:00 pm.

Bus

Bus from Mary Queen of Peace to the YMCA is available in the afternoon for an extra fee of \$6.00/day. Buses are supervised by a qualified YMCA staff.

Part Day Child Care

These programs offer preschoolers and toddler age children a variety of stimulating play and active learning opportunities. Parents may choose a combination of program times and locations to best suit the needs of each family. Programs run September to August and are based on the YMCA Playing To Learn Curriculum.
