After years of planning and with the generosity of our many donors, funders, and partners, our new Ches Penney Family Y opened on July 23, 2011.





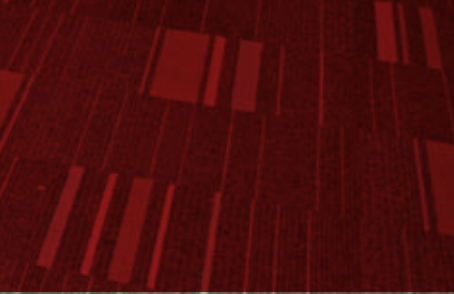
