



From the Board Chair and CEO

The past year was an important one for our YMCA as we continued to activate initiatives under our 2018-2028 strategic plan for a sustainable, relevant, and impactful organization.

We worked to keep operations sustainable in a challenging economy, to launch a new multi-year financial development plan, to continue to extend our reach across the province, and to provide support to Atlantic YMCAs through the Regional Development Centre.

Our programs have grown to include 20 program locations and 170 points of program delivery in health, fitness & aquatics, child care & day camp, and employment & enterprise.

The new YMCA project in Happy Valley-Goose Bay - our third new YMCA in less than 10 years and the first ever YMCA in Labrador - is progressing on plan. The new YMCA technology solution is set to go live next year.

Our members and participants tell us we offer programs of high and increasing quality and, for the 9th year in a row our child care programs have scored 100% in the delivery of the YMCA Playing to Learn curriculum.

Thank you to our members, participants, employees, volunteers, partners, and donors who help our YMCA have impact in our communities every day.




