Continuous Membership

YMCA memberships are automatically charged bi-weekly in accordance with the member's pre-authorized payment method. Memberships are eligible for cancellation after six (6) bi-weekly payments. Fees are based on enrollment, not usage, and are non-transferable and non-refundable.

Joiner Fee

A one-time, non-refundable Joiner Fee of \$65+HST is applied to all adult, fitness buddy, and family memberships. Memberships that are reactivated within six (6) months of cancellation will be exempt from a Joiner Fee.

Cancellation Policy

Memberships are eligible for cancellation after six (6) bi-weekly payments have been received. Only the payer on the account is authorized to cancel memberships. Cancellation requests are not accepted over the phone. To cancel your membership, visit <u>ymcanl.com</u> and complete the <u>Cancel Membership</u> <u>Form</u>. The membership will remain active until the cancellation is confirmed via email, which can take up to 72 hours to receive. For immediate cancellation, present proof of membership to a Membership Sales and Service Staff at your YMCA location, and confirmation will be provided via email.

Payment Information

- Pre-authorized payments can be applied to Visa, Master Card, American Express or personal bank accounts (a void cheque or pre-authorized payment form from your bank is required).
- Membership fees are charged on bi-weekly to your pre-authorized payment method. Charges can take several days to appear on your account.
- The YMCA is not responsible for bank fees incurred due to NSFs. Balances owing must be paid in full to access the facility or to cancel.
- The YMCA applies minimal fee increases annually. Notification will be provided 15 days prior to the scheduled increase, and failure to cancel your membership shall be deemed acceptance of the fee increase.
- It is the member's responsibility to update changes to payment and contact information (e.g., credit card expiration dates, mailing address), and the YMCA shall not be liable for any losses resulting from a member's failure to update their information.
- Payments are non-refundable, and refunds or credits are not provided for non-usage.

Conditions and Agreements

- Membership barcodes are required to be scanned upon each visit.
- Children under the age of 12 years must be accompanied by an adult (19+) while in the facility, unless signed into a staff supervised program. The exception is Child Minding where adults must remain in the facility.
- The YMCA reserves the right to modify hours of operation, programming, and to withdraw all or any part of our physical facilities for maintenance or events. The YMCA also reserves the right to suspend or terminate membership privileges, without refund, for inappropriate behaviour or failure to comply with the YMCA Etiquette Statement: "The YMCA is a shared experience for everyone to enjoy. Each of us can make it better for all by being considerate to others. YMCA members, participants, clients, visitors, staff and volunteers all pledge to treat one another with respect and dignity."
- The YMCA may change these terms and conditions by providing a minimum of 30 days written notification, and failure to cancel your membership shall be deemed acceptance of such terms and conditions.

Privacy Statement
