

## YMCA NL CHILD CARE IN BONAVISTA - UPDATE

#### November 30, 2023

**Bonavista, NL** - YMCA of Newfoundland and Labrador is collaborating with the Provincial Government on two projects for the development of regulated child care spaces for the Town of Bonavista and surrounding areas.

At Matthew Elementary there are 20 Pre-K child care spaces opening soon. Pre-K is designed for children (ages 3 years, 8 months – 5 years, 9 months) to attend for the year prior to their entry into Kindergarten. **The Pre-K waitlist registration process is now open for parents to sign their children up and can accessed at the link below.** Waitlists will remain open for all upcoming years with ongoing intake, so you may add your child's name for future years.

The recent announcement by Premier Furey about Improving Access to Early Learning and Child Care for Health Care Professionals included three new locations. These sites are to be located in St. John's, Bonavista, and Corner Brook. They are currently under development and will be operated by the YMCA. In Bonavista, the centre will be located at Discovery Collegiate.

We are working diligently to open these new centres as quickly as possible. Details on the number of spaces, waiting list registration, and opening dates will follow. More information will become available and will be posted on our website and social media pages, once the licensing process has been completed. Licensing is contingent on the completion of several steps and approvals, and most importantly, on the availability of ECEs to fill the roles needed to operate.
